Your Committees on Consumer Protection & Commerce and
Judiciary, to which was referred S.B. No. 1115, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO BUILDING DESIGN FOR PERSONS
WITH DISABILITIES,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify the scope of the
Disability and Communication Access Board's review of public
construction projects for accessibility purposes. This measure
clarifies that the Board shall review public accommodations and
commercial facilities on public lands as well as projects intended
for transfer to the State or a county.

The Disability and Communication Access Board testified in
support of this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by clarifying that
the public buildings, facilities, and sites subject to review
include buildings, facilities, sites, and the infrastructure
thereof that are constructed on lands that will be transferred to
the State or county upon completion of construction.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Consumer Protection & Commerce and Judiciary that
are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with
