"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO POLICE DEPARTMENTS,"

The purpose of this measure is to provide additional
accountability and transparency to county police departments by
requiring each county police department to post its policies
relating to domestic violence, officer-involved domestic violence,
and standards of conduct on its official website.

The Hawai'i State Democratic Women's Caucus, Hawaii State
Coalition Against Domestic Violence, League of Women Voters of
Hawaii, and two concerned individuals supported this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by amending the
preamble for brevity.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Public Safety and Labor & Public Employment that are
attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the
intent and purpose of S.B. No. 388, as amended herein, and
recommend that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto
as S.B. No. 388, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on
Judiciary.


