Specifies that the method of service of process for all civil cases under chapter 634, Hawaii Revised Statutes, when personal service is unsuccessful, shall include publication in a newspaper of general circulation three times or publication in a newspaper of general circulation at least once. Effective July 1, 2020. (SD1)	CPN, JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 1009, SD1</u></a> <a href="#"><u>(SSCR56)</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO SERVICE CHARGES. Requires hotels to distribute portorage service charges to employees in full or disclose to customers that the charges are being used for other purposes. (SD1)	TSI, JDL
