| <a href="#"><u>SB 514</u></a><br><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>  | RELATING TO THEFT OF PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES.<br>Establishes a class C felony for theft of personal electronic devices that may be used to store or retrieve personal information.  | JDL      |
