SB134 SD1 (SSCR63) Status and Testimony	<u>RELATING TO PARTITION OF HEIRS PROPERTY.</u> <u>Adopts Uniform Partition of Heirs Property Act. Establishes procedures and remedies for use in actions for partition of real property involving heirs property (real property held in tenancy in common that meets certain requirements). Effective July 1, 2020.</u> <u>(SD1)</u>	<u>CPN, JDL</u> [Measure added on 2/19/2015]
