SB 666 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MARIJUANA. Provides that possession of less than one ounce of marijuana shall be a civil rather than criminal offense. Establishes penalties for violations. Provides for enforcement, notice, and adjudication of violations.	JDL
SB 708 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MARIJUANA. Establishes a civil penalty for possession of one ounce or less of marijuana or marijuana concentrate that is subject to a fine of not more than \$100. Makes various conforming amendments to statutes to reflect the establishment of the civil violation for possession of marijuana or marijuana concentrate of one ounce or less.	JDL
SB 879 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MARIJUANA. Establishes a civil violation subject to a fine of \$100 for intentional or knowing possession of one ounce or less of marijuana.	JDL
