HB 496, HD1 (HSCR741) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT. Establishes a partial wage replacement for leave trust fund funded by employee wage withholdings. Uses the trust fund to provide partial wage replacement for four weeks of family leave. Appropriates moneys to administer the trust fund. (HB496 HD1)	JDL, WAM
HB 1268, HD2 (HSCR841) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION. Requires injured public employees who are eligible to take part in an employer's return to work program do so as a prerequisite to receiving vocational rehabilitation through workers' compensation coverage. (HB1268 HD2)	JDL, WAM
HB 1185, HD1 (HSCR807) Status & Testimony	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 13, OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, TO AMEND THE TIMING OF MATURATION FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS. Proposes to amend the State Constitution by requiring the first principal installment of general obligation bonds and reimbursable general obligation bonds to mature not later than one year from the date of issuance. (HB1185 HD1)	JDL, WAM
