SB 1151, SD1 (SSCR101) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Authorizes restaurants and retail dealers with a liquor license to sell beer, malt beverages, or cider for off-premises consumption, under certain conditions. Authorizes brewpubs and small craft producer pubs with a liquor license to sell malt beverages purchased from another liquor licensee for off-premises consumption. Effective July 1, 2020. (SD1)	CPN, PSM
SB 868 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LIQUOR COMMISSIONS. Requires county liquor commissions that choose to regulate dancing to adopt or amend rules regarding limitations on dancing.	PSM
SB 1154 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE LIQUOR COMMISSION. For counties with a population of five hundred thousand or more: requires a public hearing before the liquor commission on an application for a liquor license to be held not less than thirty days after the first public notice for the hearing.	PSM
