SB 119 Status & Testimony	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS. Makes appropriation for the public employment cost items of and cost adjustments for employees of the various legislative agencies.	WAM
SB 92, SD1 (SSCR531) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TAXATION. Requires DOTAX to publish reports on certain general excise tax exemptions. Repeals specific annual reporting deadlines. (SD1)	WAM
SB 1092 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF NON-GENERAL FUNDS. Repeal of various non-general fund accounts and transfers the balance of the fee simple residential revolving fund to the general fund.	WAM
SB 1092 Proposed SD1 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF NON-GENERAL FUNDS. Repeals the pineapple workers and retirees housing assistance fund, the state disaster revolving loan fund, and the transportation use special fund.
