<u>SB 1221, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR89)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires the department of education to provide care to students with diabetes pursuant to a student's diabetes medical management plan. (SD1)	EDU/HTH, WAM
<u>SB 846</u> <u>(SSCR90)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Authorizes Department of Education (DOE) employees and agents to volunteer to administer auto-injectable epinephrine to a student with anaphylaxis in an emergency situation. Allows DOE to make arrangements to receive auto-injectable epinephrine supplies from manufacturers or suppliers. Requires DOE to report on the status of implementation.	EDU/HTH, WAM
<u>SB 504, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR363)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Amends the definition of "historic property" to include the requirement that the property be eligible for listing on the Hawaii register of historic places or is located in a historic district. Requires the state historic preservation division of the department of land and natural resources to conduct a survey on properties eligible for listing on the Hawaii register of historic places and to provide owners of historic property with notice of the property's likely eligibility. Appropriates funds to conduct the survey and notify property owners. Effective 7/1/2050. Repeals 12/31/2018. (SD1)	HEA/WTL, WAM
<u>SB 382, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR441)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Establishes within the livestock revitalization program a grant program for qualified feed developers. Appropriates funds. (SD1)	AGL, WAM

RELATING TO HEALTH.

HTH/CPN, WAM

Establishes licensure requirement for durable medical equipment suppliers through an annual inspection by the office of health care assurance. Appropriates funds from the office of health care assurance special fund to administer the durable medical equipment licensing program. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
