Establishes a family leave insurance program, which requires employees to make contributions into a trust fund to be used to provide employees with family leave insurance benefits in order to care for a designated person. Appropriates funds to DLIR to implement the program.	LAB, FIN
HB810	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Appropriates funds for the P4C Program of the University of Hawaii Uehiro Academy for Philosophy and Ethics in Education and for teachers of the Department of Education to train with the P4C Program.	FIN
HB894, HD1	RELATING TO THE ENHANCED 911 BOARD. Provides the Enhanced 911 Board with the authority to hire employees. (HB894 HD1)	LAB, FIN
