# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KING KAMEHAMEHA CELEBRATION COMMISSION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 8-5, Hawaii  
2 Revised Statutes, establishes the King Kamehameha celebration  
3 commission, which is the coordinating agency for all  
4 celebrations commemorating King Kamehameha I, generally observed  
5 throughout Hawaii on June 11th of each year.

6           The legislature further finds that regular oversight is  
7 beneficial to the smooth operation of government commissions.  
8 This oversight often takes the form of financial and management  
9 audits conducted by the office of the auditor.

10           The purpose of this Act is to require the auditor to  
11 conduct a financial and management audit of the King Kamehameha  
12 celebration commission.

13           SECTION 2. The auditor is required to conduct a financial  
14 and management audit of the King Kamehameha celebration  
15 commission.

16           The auditor shall submit a report of any findings or  
17 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the










