Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred
S.B. No. 2835 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE
BARGAINING COST ITEMS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to appropriate and
authorize funds for the collective bargaining agreement for
employees in collective bargaining unit (8) and their excluded
counterparts.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Budget and Finance, University of Hawai'i
System, and Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local
152, AFL-CIO.

Your Committee finds that in November 2015, the arbitration
panel issued an award for public employees in collective
bargaining unit (8), and this measure provides a legislative
vehicle to effectuate the terms and conditions of the arbitrated
award for public employees in collective bargaining unit (8).

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and
consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report,
