
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SMALL BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the small business
2 regulatory review board provides comment and input into the
3 administrative rulemaking process, and provides recommendations
4 to the legislature, governor, and the counties on rule changes
5 in order to help small businesses. The legislature also finds
6 that the board lacks sufficient staff to fulfill its mission
7 effectively.

8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
9 department of business, economic development, and tourism so
10 that the small business regulatory review board can acquire the
11 necessary additional staff.

12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
16 2016-2017 for the small business regulatory review board to
17 acquire additional staff.

1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
3 of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
