A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
AND TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:
4 "§201- Inter-agency agreements; memoranda of agreement;
5 memoranda of understanding. (a) The department of business,
6 economic development, and tourism may develop, and any state
7 agency, may enter into, and implement inter-agency agreements to
8 coordinate resources, eliminate unnecessary duplication, and
9 effectuate the purposes of their respective chapter, without
10 entering into a memorandum of agreement or memorandum of
11 understanding.
12 (b) In addition to any other terms or conditions required
13 by law, any inter-agency agreement between the authority and
14 state agency, office, department, or other administrative
15 subdivision shall contain the following:
16 (1) A termination date;


- 1 (2) A statement of intent and purpose;
- 2 (3) Terms specifying the extent of the inter-agency
- 3 agreement's applicability; and
- 4 (4) Terms under which the inter-agency agreement may be
- 5 modified or extended."

6 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
