
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRIVATE FLIGHT SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 305J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§305J- Private flight schools; regulation or
5 authorization. The department, at its discretion, may regulate
6 or authorize a private flight school that:

- 7 (1) Is physically present in the State;
8 (2) Is certified by the Federal Aviation Administration;
9 (3) Offers a degree or instruction that qualifies an
10 individual to take federal aviation administration
11 flight qualification examinations;
12 (4) Offers an advanced certificate for flight instructors;
13 (5) Requests department authorization; and
14 (6) Meets any other requirements established by the
15 department by rule,



1 for the purposes of qualifying the flight school to participate
2 in loan programs established pursuant to Title IV of the Higher
3 Education Act of 1965, as amended."

4 SECTION 2. Section 305J-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

6 "(b) To administer this chapter, the department shall:

- 7 (1) Maintain a list of the private colleges or
8 universities, seminaries, and religious training
9 institutions that have been authorized and make this
10 list available to the public;
- 11 (2) Maintain a list of the states with which the director
12 has entered into a post-secondary education
13 authorization reciprocity agreement and make this list
14 available to the public; and
- 15 (3) Receive, arbitrate, investigate, and process
16 complaints[-]; provided that this paragraph shall not
17 apply to complaints against a flight school authorized
18 and regulated under section 305J- ."

19 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

21 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.

Requires the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to authorize and regulate private flight schools that meet certain requirements. Relieves the Department of the duty to receive, arbitrate, investigate, and process complaints made against flight schools. (HB190 HD2)
