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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1: Section 261-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "Transportation network company driver" means an  
5 individual who operates a personal vehicle that:

6           (1) Is used to transport a passenger between points chosen  
7 by the passenger and prearranged through a  
8 transportation network company;

9           (2) Is owned, leased, or otherwise authorized for use by  
10 the individual;

11           (3) Is not a taxicab or for-hire vehicle; and

12           (4) Is used to provide prearranged rides to passengers."

13           SECTION 2. Section 261-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
14 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

15           "(a) Powers to adopt. The director of transportation may  
16 perform such acts, issue and amend such orders, adopt such  
17 reasonable general or special rules and procedures, and



1 establish such minimum standards, consistent with this chapter,  
2 as the director deems necessary to carry out this chapter and to  
3 perform the duties assigned thereunder, all commensurate with  
4 and for the purpose of protecting and insuring the general  
5 public interest and safety, the safety of persons operating,  
6 using, or traveling in aircraft, and the safety of persons and  
7 property on land or water, and developing and promoting  
8 aeronautics in the State.

9 In furtherance of the duties assigned under this chapter,  
10 the director may adopt rules relating to:

- 11 (1) Safety measures, requirements and practices in or  
12 about the airport premises;
- 13 (2) The licensing and regulation of persons engaged in  
14 commercial activities in or about the airport  
15 premises;
- 16 (3) The regulation of equipment and motor vehicles  
17 operated in or about the airport operational area;
- 18 (4) Airport security measures or requirements, and  
19 designation of sterile passenger holding areas and  
20 operational areas;
- 21 (5) The regulation of motor vehicles and traffic;



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1 (6) Any other matter relating to the health, safety and  
 2 welfare of the general public and persons operating,  
 3 using, or traveling in aircraft[-];

4 (7) The licensing and regulation of transportation network  
 5 company drivers in or about airport premises."

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
