
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:
4 "§321- License, relicense, certification, and
5 recertification fees. (a) Notwithstanding section 321.11.5,
6 the department shall charge and collect fees for the licensure,
7 relicensure, certification, and recertification of the following
8 facilities:
9 (1) Not more than \$ per year for adult residential
10 care homes;
11 (2) Not more than \$ per year for expanded adult
12 residential care homes;
13 (3) Not more than \$ per year for developmental
14 disabilities domiciliary homes;
15 (4) Not more than \$ per year for community care
16 foster family homes;



1 (5) Not more than \$ per year for adult day care
2 centers;

3 (6) Not more than \$ per year for adult foster
4 homes for developmentally disabled individuals;

5 (7) Not more than \$ per year for other homes
6 specified in section 346-53; and

7 (8) Not more than \$ per year for case managers
8 having purview of facilities specified in paragraphs
9 (1) to (7).

10 (b) The fees shall be deposited into the general fund to
11 support the licensing, relicensing, certification, and
12 recertification of facilities under this section.

13 (c) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
14 91 as necessary to carry out the purposes of this section."

15 SECTION 2. The department of health shall submit a report
16 to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
17 convening of the regular session of 2018 on the following:

18 (1) The nexus and use of the fees collected pursuant to
19 this Act;

20 (2) A brief description of any operational problems or
21 legal impediments that are anticipated to affect



1 collection of the fees or have affected collection of
2 the fees; and

3 (3) With respect to community care facilities, a cost
4 analysis on the savings to the State in relation to
5 providing health care services to the elderly and
6 disabled persons.

7 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
