Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred
H.B. No. 218 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FORECLOSURES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase transparency in
the foreclosure process by requiring that notice of public sales,
including postponed or cancelled sales, be published both
electronically and once in each of three consecutive weeks in a
newspaper of general circulation in the affected county.

A concerned individual supported this measure. Porter
McGuire Kiakona & Chow, LLP and Associa opposed this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Intrastate Commerce that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 218 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred
to your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
