Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 801, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CHILD SUPPORT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require:

- (1) Certain amounts of child support moneys collected by the Department of Human Services (DHS) for public assistance of a child to pass through to the family receiving the public assistance; and
- (2) DHS to disregard passed-through child support payments when determining the needs of an applicant or recipient of public assistance.


The Department of Human Services and Department of the Attorney General commented on this measure.
