419, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SELECTIVE SERVICE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase awareness of and  
compliance with Selective Service registration by requiring  
compliance with the Military Selective Service Act to be eligible:

- (1) To enroll in or receive education from a State-supported  
post-secondary educational institution;
- (2) To receive a loan, grant, scholarship, or other  
financial assistance for post-secondary education that  
is provided, supported, or guaranteed by the State; and
- (3) For employment by or service with the State or any  
county.

The Hawaii State Director of the United States Selective  
Service System and a concerned individual supported this measure.  
The Hawaii Civil Rights Commission, American Civil Liberties Union  
of Hawaii, Hawaii Friends of Civil Rights, University of Hawaii




Student Caucus, and several concerned individuals opposed the measure. The University of Hawaii and a concerned individual submitted comments.
