The purpose and intent of this measure is to request the
Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to enter
into an agreement with certain agencies to develop a master plan
for the Hilo International Aerospace and Technology Park.

Your Committee received written comments on this measure from
the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; and
High Technology Development Corporation.

Your Committee finds that the Hilo area is appropriate for
the development and operation of an international park for
aerospace and technology activities. Your Committee further finds
that the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism
is the appropriate agency to lead the collaborative effort to
develop a master plan for the park. Your Committee emphasizes



that the Department should be aware that the cost of the park must be affordable to the State.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Ways and Means that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 129 and recommends its adoption.
