
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3 "(a) Any person who uses a parking space reserved for
4 persons with disabilities who:
5 (1) Fails to properly display a removable windshield
6 placard, a temporary removable windshield placard, or
7 special license plates;
8 (2) Displays an invalid removable windshield placard, an
9 invalid temporary removable windshield placard, or
10 invalid special license plates;
11 (3) Uses a removable windshield placard, a temporary
12 removable windshield placard, or special license plate
13 that was not issued to that person or to any
14 passengers occupying the vehicle in the parking space;
15 or



1 (4) With or without a removable windshield placard, a
2 temporary removable windshield placard, or special
3 license plates:
4 (A) Parks in an access aisle; or
5 (B) Obstructs the ingress or egress to a parking
6 space reserved for a person with a disability;
7 shall be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and
8 shall be fined not less than [~~\$250 nor~~] \$500 for a first time
9 violation and not more than [~~\$500~~] \$1,000 for any subsequent
10 violation and shall pay any costs incurred by the court related
11 to assessing the fine; provided that a person with a disability
12 who has been issued a valid placard or special license plate
13 that is currently in effect, and who has failed to display the
14 placard or license plate while parking in a space reserved for
15 persons with disabilities, shall pay a fine of not less than \$25
16 nor more than \$100 and any costs incurred by the court related
17 to assessing the fine.

18 (b) Any person who uses a parking space reserved for
19 persons with disabilities and refuses or fails to present an
20 identification card issued under this chapter or the rules
21 adopted thereunder to an enforcement officer upon request shall



1 be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and shall
 2 be fined not less than [~~\$250~~] \$500 for a first time
 3 violation and not more than [~~\$500~~] \$1,000 for any subsequent
 4 violation."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
