A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ARTS PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely
4 for the following purposes:

5 (1) Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,
6 including any consultant or staff services required to
7 carry out the art in public places and relocatable
8 works of art programs;

9 (2) Site modifications, display, and interpretive work
10 necessary for the exhibition of works of art;

11 (3) Upkeep services, including maintenance, repair, and
12 restoration of works of art;

13 (4) Storing and transporting works of art ~~[]~~ i;

14 (5) Arts programs within any public school; and

15 (6) Arts programs within the University of Hawaii system."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
