
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE RECYCLING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 339D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[~~+~~]**§339D-10**[~~+~~] **Electronic device recycling fund.** (a)

4 There is established in the state treasury the electronic device
5 recycling fund into which shall be deposited all fees, payments,
6 and penalties collected by the department pursuant to this
7 chapter.

8 (b) The electronic device recycling fund shall be
9 administered by the department of health. Moneys in the fund
10 shall be expended by the director [~~solely~~] for the purpose of
11 implementing [~~and enforcing~~] this chapter[-], including:

12 (1) Reimbursement for collection services associated with
13 the handling and collecting of electronic devices for
14 recycling;

15 (2) Funding administrative, audit, and compliance
16 activities associated with collection and payment of
17 all fees, payments, and penalties imposed by the
18 department pursuant to this chapter;



- 1 (3) Conducting electronic recycling education and
- 2 demonstration projects;
- 3 (4) Supporting the handling and transportation of the
- 4 electronic devices collected to end-markets; and
- 5 (5) Supporting county electronics collections.
- 6 (c) Any funds that accumulate in the electronic device
- 7 recycling fund shall be retained in the fund unless determined
- 8 by the legislature to be in excess."

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and
12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2018-2019 as a grant-in aid to the county of Hawaii for
14 expenses related to the services associated with handling and
15 collecting electronic devices for recycling pursuant to chapter
16 339D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of
18 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and



1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2018-2019 as a grant-in aid to the county of Kauai for
3 expenses related to the services associated with handling and
4 collecting electronic devices for recycling pursuant to chapter
5 339D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of
7 Kauai for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and
11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 2018-2019 as a grant-in aid to the county of Maui for
13 expenses related to the services associated with handling and
14 collecting electronic devices for recycling pursuant to chapter
15 339D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of
17 Maui for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

20 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
