
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part VI of article 10A to be
3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4 "§431:10A- Limited-duration health insurance prohibited.
5 (a) No health insurer shall offer or provide limited-duration
6 health insurance coverage to individuals in the State.
7 (b) For the purposes of this section, "limited-duration
8 health insurance coverage" means health insurance coverage
9 provided to an individual under a contract offered by a licensed
10 health insurer, regardless of the situs of the delivery of the
11 policy or contract, that has a specified, limited duration of
12 less than ninety-one days and does not meet all of the
13 requirements otherwise applicable to individual health insurance
14 coverage."
15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
