
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§134- Multiburst trigger activator; prohibition. (a)
5 Any person in this State who manufactures or causes to be
6 manufactured, imports into the State, keeps for sale, or offers
7 or exposes for sale, or who gives, lends, or possesses any
8 multiburst trigger activator shall be guilty of a class C
9 felony.

10 (b) As used in this section, "multiburst trigger
11 activator" means:

12 (1) A device that simulates automatic gunfire by allowing
13 standard function of a semiautomatic firearm with a
14 static positioned trigger finger or a device that
15 fires multiple shots with the pull and release of the
16 trigger; or



1 (2) A manual or power-driven trigger activating device
2 constructed and designed so that when attached to a
3 semiautomatic firearm it simulates automatic gunfire."

4 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
