
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PUBLIC EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's public
2 schools are charged with making students college and career
3 ready. The legislature also finds that schools are being
4 challenged to transform the ways in which they educate students
5 in order to provide students with the skills and competencies
6 needed to compete and succeed in an ever-changing globalized
7 world. Public school students must compete not only with other
8 students statewide, but with students nationwide and globally.

9 The legislature recognizes that an effective public
10 education system is one that offers world-class instruction
11 through highly effective teachers and curricula. To support
12 student learning and student success, schools must be provided
13 with adequate and increased funding to provide the resources
14 necessary for student achievement.

15 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
16 department of education for school-level funding to support
17 student learning and student success.
