RECOGNIZING APRIL 7 THROUGH APRIL 13, 2019, AS VOLUNTEER WEEK IN
THE STATE OF HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week was first designated by
2 Presidential Proclamation 4288 from President Richard Nixon in
3 1974 to recognize and encourage people to engage in their
4 community through volunteer service; and

6 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week works to inspire, equip,
7 and mobilize people to take actions that can change the world;

10 WHEREAS, individuals and communities are at the center of
11 social change, discovering their power to make a difference; and

13 WHEREAS, during National Volunteer Week, service projects
14 will be performed across America and volunteers will be
15 recognized for their commitment to service; and

17 WHEREAS, the giving of oneself in service to another
18 empowers the giver and the recipient, and experience teaches
19 that government by itself cannot solve all of the issues facing
20 the United States of America; and

22 WHEREAS, the United States of America volunteer force of
23 over 63,000,000 is a great treasure, and those who volunteer
24 play a vital role in the community and in the United States'
25 future as a caring and productive nation; and

27 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this body proclaim the week
28 of April 7 through April 13, 2019, as Volunteer Week in the
29 State of Hawaii in conjunction with the observance of National
30 Volunteer Week; and
