A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL IDENTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3 "(b) Application for renewal of an identification card
4 issued after November 1, 1998, for an individual eighty years of
5 age or older may be done by mailing in a completed application
6 and fee, if there is no change in name and citizenship status.
7 The director shall adopt rules to allow for renewal by mail for
8 individuals with physical or intellectual disabilities for whom
9 application in person presents a serious burden. For an
10 individual who has a physician's letter certifying that a severe
11 disability causes the individual to be homebound, the director
12 shall adopt rules allowing for application for renewal of an
13 identification card under this section by means other than in
14 person appearance."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
