
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the fireworks
2 display permit fee, which authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to
3 conduct outdoor and close proximity fireworks for special public
4 or private events and theatrical or movie purposes, has remained
5 the same for fourteen years, but the cost to process, review,
6 and approve display permits has increased. The legislature also
7 finds that fees need to keep pace with governmental
8 administrative costs.

9 The purpose of this Act is to raise the fireworks display
10 permit fee from \$110 to \$300.

11 SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 "§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the
14 purchase and use of:

15 (1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
16 upon payment of a fee of \$25;



1 (2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
2 pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon
3 payment of a fee of [~~\$110,~~] \$300; and

4 (3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section
5 132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time
6 other than during the periods prescribed in section
7 132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25."

8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
