
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION TO
PROHIBIT INDIVIDUALS FROM APPROACHING WITHIN FIFTY FEET OF
A HAWAIIAN MONK SEAL EXCEPT WHEN PROVIDING AID TO THE
HAWAIIAN MONK SEAL.

1 WHEREAS, in order to protect the population of Hawaiian
2 monk seals (*Neomonachus schauinslandi*), it is necessary to limit
3 human interaction with them; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the Hawaiian monk seal is one of the world's most
6 critically endangered species of marine mammal; and
7

8 WHEREAS, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
9 Administration has reported that a number of habituated seals
10 have become a serious safety risk to humans, or suffered
11 injuries as a result of human infringement and interaction; and
12

13 WHEREAS, other harmful human interactions have reportedly
14 occurred when Hawaiian monk seals were fed by people; and
15

16 WHEREAS, when the seal becomes focused on the source of
17 food, the seal may begin to beg for the food more aggressively;
18 and

20 WHEREAS, Hawaiian monk seals have sustained injury from
21 boat propellers or ingestion of fishing hooks as they attempt to
22 access human food sources near boats and docks; and

24 WHEREAS, in most cases, once a Hawaiian monk seal has been
25 socialized to interact with humans, there are few options to
26 extinguish this behavior; and

28 WHEREAS, Hawaiian monk seals are protected by the
29 Endangered Species Act and the Marine Mammal Protection Act,
30 which make it illegal under federal law to harass Hawaiian monk



1 seals, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration
2 encourages people to stay a safe distance away from Hawaiian
3 monk seals; now, therefore,

4
5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
6 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the
7 House of Representatives concurring, that the National Oceanic
8 and Atmospheric Administration is urged to prohibit individuals
9 from approaching within fifty feet of a Hawaiian monk seal,
10 except for a licensed professional that is qualified to provide
11 aid to the Hawaiian monk seal, such as first responders and
12 veterinarians; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
15 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Assistant Secretary
16 of Commerce for Oceans and Atmosphere for the Department of
17 Commerce in the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration
18 and Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources.
