# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE MAYORS OF THE STATE'S COUNTIES TO SUBMIT A PLAN  
DETAILING HOW EACH COUNTY WILL MEET ITS PLEDGE TO ELIMINATE  
FOSSIL FUELS FROM GROUND TRANSPORTATION BY 2045.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaii's dependence on imported fossil fuels  
2 drains the state economy of billions of dollars each year, and  
3 the volatility of imported fuel prices creates significant risks  
4 for the economy and adds to costs for local families; and  
5

6 WHEREAS, the use of fossil fuels reduces air quality and  
7 contributes to climate change through increased greenhouse gas  
8 emissions in the atmosphere; and  
9

10 WHEREAS, on a per-mile basis, it is less expensive to  
11 commute in an electric vehicle than it is to commute in a gas-  
12 powered vehicle; and  
13

14 WHEREAS, according to the Hawaii State Energy Office,  
15 ground transportation accounted for an estimated twenty-six  
16 percent of Hawaii's fossil fuel usage in 2015; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, of the more than one million passenger vehicles  
19 registered in the State, only about six thousand nine hundred  
20 are fully electric and only about twenty-five thousand are  
21 hybrid vehicles; and

23 WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017, the Mayors of the City and  
24 County of Honolulu, County of Maui, County of Hawaii, and County  
25 of Kauai signed a corresponding proclamation to eliminate fossil  
26 fuels from all ground transportation, public and private, by  
27 2045; and

29 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu and the County of  
30 Maui also pledged to transition all of their fleet vehicles to  
31 one hundred percent clean energy by 2035; now, therefore,

2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth  
3 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the  
4 House of Representatives concurring, that the City and County of  
5 Honolulu, County of Maui, County of Hawaii, and County of Kauai  
6 Mayors are requested to submit a plan detailing how each county  
7 intends to meet its pledge of eliminating fossil fuels from  
8 ground transportation by 2045; and  
9

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each county is requested to  
11 consider installing electric vehicle charging ports and  
12 converting its bus fleets to renewable technology as part of its  
13 plan; and  
14

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each county is requested to  
16 submit its plan to the Legislature no later than twenty days  
17 prior to the start of the Regular Session of 2019; and  
18

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
20 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City  
21 and County of Honolulu, Mayor of the County of Maui, Mayor of  
22 the County of Hawaii, and Mayor of the County of Kauai.
