SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING FEDERAL FUNDING TO PROVIDE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS
IN EVERY SCHOOL IN HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, there have been a number of recent school
2 shootings reported in the news across the country, including
3 Parkland, Florida; and Benton, Kentucky; and
4

5 WHEREAS, in Parkland, Florida, a gunman killed seventeen
6 unsuspecting students and adults at Marjory Stoneman Douglas
7 High School, and in Benton, Kentucky, a student shot sixteen
8 students, killing two other students, at Marshall County High
9 School; and
10

11 WHEREAS, in light of the recent increase in school
12 violence, it is imperative that federal funding go toward
13 protecting the students of Hawaii; and
14

15 WHEREAS, a valuable resource to ensuring safer schools
16 where students can thrive are school resource officers; and
17

18 WHEREAS, a school resource officer is a career law
19 enforcement officer with sworn authority responsible for safety
20 and crime prevention in schools; and

22 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice Office of
23 Community Oriented Policing Services offers grants to cities and
24 counties for creating law enforcement positions, including
25 school resource officer positions; and

27 WHEREAS, in 2016, the United States Departments of
28 Education and Justice jointly released the Safe, School-based
29 Enforcement through Collaboration, Understanding, and Respect
30 Rubrics to help education and law enforcement agencies that use
31 school resource officers to review and revise policies to
32 improve school safety and better outcomes for students; and

1 WHEREAS, school resource officers also have the opportunity
 2 to build trust and gain respect from students by providing
 3 positive police interaction and outreach to students; now,
 4 therefore,

 6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
 7 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the
 8 House of Representatives concurring, that federal funding is
 9 requested to provide school resource officers in every school in
 10 Hawaii; and

 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 13 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to members of Hawaii's
 14 congressional delegation.
