Your Committees on Judiciary, Economic Development, Tourism, and Technology, and Higher Education, to which was referred S.B. No. 3037 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to appropriate monies for the Office of International Affairs to fund one or more programs sponsored or organized by the University of Hawaii Community Colleges or a four-year campus to implement international college experiences for Hawaii students enrolled at a University of Hawaii campus.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the University of Hawaii West Oahu, Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, and one individual. Your Committees received comments on this measure from the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; and University of Hawai'i System.


Your Committees find that the opportunity to study abroad helps students to become globally competitive by broadening their views, learning new languages, and being exposed to diverse cultures. Education abroad programs have been demonstrated to contribute to students' success and preparation. This measure will provide resources to give Hawaii's students the opportunity




to build upon the cultural and historic ties between the State and nations throughout the Asia-Pacific region and expose students to these nations in an educational and cultural setting.




