SHOULDER OF HALEAKALA HIGHWAY BETWEEN UPPER KIMO DRIVE AND
AINAKULA ROAD AND TO EXAMINE POTENTIAL PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to ensure the safety of
pedestrians by requesting the Highways Division of the Department
of Transportation to:

- (1) Assess the dangers of pedestrian use of the shoulder on
the portion of Haleakala Highway between Upper Kimo
Drive and Ainakula Road;
- (2) Examine the effectiveness of potential pedestrian safety
countermeasures; and
- (3) Submit a report of its findings and recommendations,
including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature
no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
Regular Session of 2019.



The Department of Transportation and Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i testified in support of this measure.
