Sir:

Your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health,
to which was referred S.R. No. 74, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE RESOLUTION REQUESTS THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO
CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO IDENTIFY BARRIERS AND SOLUTIONS TO
EXPANDED WATER REUSE IN THE STATE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to request the
Department of Health to convene a task force to identify barriers
and solutions to expanded water reuse in the State, and to request
the task force to submit its findings and recommendations in a
report to the Legislature.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Health, Ulupono Initiative, Hawai'i
Community Foundation, O'ahu County Committee on Legislative
Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, Wai Maoli Hawai'i
Fresh Water Initiative, Board of Water Supply of the City and
County of Honolulu, The Nature Conservancy of Hawai'i, and one
individual.

Your Committee finds that decreasing rainfall, increasing
evaporation from rising temperatures, and increasing demand from
population growth combine to place pressure on the State's fresh
water supply. Your Committee further finds that increasing the
amount of water reuse in the State will alleviate pressure on the




State's fresh water supply. Accordingly, your Committee finds that the State would benefit from a task force to identify barriers and solutions to expanded water reuse in the State.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Adding a representative from a public agency with permitting or implementation authority over wastewater to the membership of the task force; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.R. No. 74, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as S.R. No. 74, S.D. 2.
