A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTS OF CANDIDATE COMMITTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-322, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The candidate committee organizational report shall
4 include:
- 5 (1) The committee's name and address, including web page
6 address, if any;
 - 7 (2) The candidate's name, address, and telephone number;
 - 8 (3) The office being sought by the candidate, district,
9 and party affiliation;
 - 10 (4) The chairperson's name and address and, if appointed,
11 the deputy chairperson's name and address;
 - 12 (5) The treasurer's name and address and, if appointed,
13 all deputy treasurers' names and addresses;
 - 14 (6) The name and address of each depository institution in
15 which the committee will maintain any of its accounts
16 and the applicable account number; and
 - 17 (7) A certification by the candidate and treasurer of the
18 statements in the organizational report [~~and~~



1 ~~(8) The name and address of each contributor who~~
2 ~~contributed an aggregate amount of more than \$100 to~~
3 ~~the candidate committee since the last election~~
4 ~~applicable to the office being sought and the amount~~
5 ~~and date of deposit of each such contribution]."~~

6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.


