RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, as  
2 amended by Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, and Acts 29 and  
3 49, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is amended as follows:

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.




