A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "confidential personal
3 information" to read as follows:
4 "Confidential personal information" means information in
5 which an individual has a significant privacy interest,
6 including but not limited to [a] an individual's entire driver's
7 license number[~~7-a~~] or social security number[~~7-an~~]; the entire
8 identifying number of [a] an individual's depository,
9 investment, or credit account [~~7-a bank account number, a~~
10 password or other information that is used for accessing
11 information, or any other name, number, or code that is used,
12 alone or in conjunction with other information, to confirm the
13 identity of a person.]; an individual's entire credit card
14 number; or a username and password that, when used in
15 conjunction, provide access to an individual's credit card
16 account, medical records, or depository, investment, or credit
17 account."



1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
