
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Maui county has the
2 highest rate of youth suicide attempts in the State and has
3 become a serious concern for the community and State overall.

4 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
5 youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education
6 initiatives in Maui county.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$25,000 or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to support
10 youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education
11 initiatives in Maui county that focus upon, but are not limited
12 to, persons between the ages of ten and twenty-four.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14 health for purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
