
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTAL ASSISTANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The board of dental examiners shall adopt rules
2 pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to establish a
3 regulatory structure for the regulation of dental assistants in
4 Hawaii via the following certification options that shall
5 establish educational criteria and permitted duties:
- 6 (1) Basic-level dental assistants, who shall have
7 graduated from high school or earned a general
8 equivalency diploma;
- 9 (2) Certified dental assistants, who shall have:
- 10 (A) Graduated from high school or earned a general
11 equivalency diploma; and
- 12 (B) Successfully passed the certification examination
13 administered by the Dental Assisting National
14 Board, Inc.; and
- 15 (3) Advanced-qualified dental assistants, who shall have:
- 16 (A) Graduated from high school or earned a general
17 equivalency diploma;


4 (C) Received training in the application of pit and
5 fissure sealants or advanced remediable intra-
6 oral dental tasks.

7 SECTION 2. No later than twenty days prior to the
8 convening of the regular session of 2019, the board of dental
9 examiners shall submit to the legislature a report detailing the
10 rules adopted pursuant to section 1 of this Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
