
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) No person who is a fugitive from justice or is a
4 person prohibited from possessing firearms or ammunition under
5 federal law shall own, possess, or control any firearm or
6 ammunition therefor[-]; provided that this subsection shall not
7 apply to any person solely because that person is authorized to
8 use cannabis for medical purposes under part IX of chapter 329."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
