A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending its title and subsections (a) and (b) to
3 read as follows:

4 "§134-8 Ownership, etc., of automatic firearms, silencers,
5 trigger modification devices, etc., prohibited; penalties. (a)
6 The manufacture, possession, sale, barter, trade, gift,
7 transfer, or acquisition of any of the following is prohibited:
8 assault pistols, except as provided by section 134-4(e);
9 automatic firearms; rifles with barrel lengths less than sixteen
10 inches; shotguns with barrel lengths less than eighteen inches;
11 cannons; mufflers, silencers, or devices for deadening or
12 muffling the sound of discharged firearms; hand grenades,
13 dynamite, blasting caps, bombs, or bombshells, or other
14 explosives; a trigger modification device, bump stock or bump
15 fire device, trigger crank, or any part, combination of parts,
16 component, device, attachment, or accessory that is designed or
17 functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic
