
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Article XI, section 3 of the Hawaii State
2 Constitution establishes the State's duty to "conserve and
3 protect agricultural lands, promote diversified agriculture,
4 increase agricultural self-sufficiency and assure the
5 availability of agriculturally suitable lands" and provides
6 protections for lands identified as important agricultural
7 lands. As part of its duty, the legislature enacted Act 183,
8 Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, which was codified in part III of
9 chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

10 Act 183 directed each county to work with government and
11 community stakeholders to identify and map potential important
12 agricultural lands within sixty months of receipt of state funds
13 and make recommendations to the state land use commission for
14 the designation of these lands as important agricultural lands.
15 Once designated, agricultural operations on important
16 agricultural lands are eligible for a variety of state and
17 county assistance and incentive programs including grants and



1 other funding assistance, tax incentives, favorable
 2 infrastructure and permit requirements, and farm and business
 3 education assistance. The legislature finds that, to date, most
 4 counties have not received state funds to assist with their
 5 identification and mapping duties under Act 183.

6 The purpose of this Act is to implement Act 183 in
 7 accordance with the State's constitutional duty to protect
 8 important agricultural lands by providing funds to the counties
 9 for the identification and mapping of important agricultural
 10 lands.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
 14 grants-in-aid to the counties for the identification and mapping
 15 of important agricultural lands pursuant to section 205-47,
 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to be allocated as follows:

- 17 (1) \$ to the county of Hawaii;
- 18 (2) \$ to the city and county of Honolulu;
- 19 (3) \$ to the county of Kauai; and
- 20 (4) \$ to the county of Maui;



1 provided that the amounts appropriated in paragraphs (2) and (3)
2 may be expended to reimburse those counties for important
3 agricultural land mapping work that has been completed.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
6 this Act

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
