# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE HAWAII STATE  
CAPITOL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds  
2 to the state foundation on culture and the arts to provide  
3 support for the task force established by Senate Concurrent  
4 Resolution No. 81, Regular Session of 2016, to plan and  
5 coordinate the celebration of the fiftieth anniversary of the  
6 Hawaii state capitol. The celebration shall include various  
7 program activities and events from March 15, 2018, through  
8 March 15, 2019, including the establishment of a kiosk or shop  
9 on the grounds of the Hawaii state capitol to disseminate  
10 information and other materials and items, for free and for  
11 sale, regarding the Hawaii state capitol and its history to  
12 visitors to the state capitol, including tourists.

13           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$           or so much  
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to plan  
16 and coordinate the celebration of the fiftieth anniversary of



1 the Hawaii state capitol; provided that the state foundation of  
2 culture and the arts shall use a portion of the funds for the  
3 establishment of a kiosk or shop on the grounds of the Hawaii  
4 state capitol to disseminate information and other materials and  
5 items, for free and for sale, regarding the Hawaii state capitol  
6 and its history to visitors to the state capitol, including  
7 tourists.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state  
9 foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 15, 2015.



**Report Title:**

State Capitol; 50th Anniversary; State Foundation on Culture and the Arts; Appropriation

**Description:**

Appropriates funds to the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts to fund celebrations for the 50th anniversary of the Hawaii state capitol. Requires the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts to use a portion of the appropriated funds to establish a kiosk or shop to disseminate information about the state capitol to visitors to the state capitol.
