SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO REDISTRIBUTE STUDENTS WHO
WILL BE LIVING IN THE KOA RIDGE DEVELOPMENT TO THE PEARL
CITY-WAIPAHAU COMPLEX AREA.

1 WHEREAS, the Koa Ridge development has started construction
2 on three thousand five hundred new housing units in central
3 Oahu; and
4

5 WHEREAS, once completed, the development will offer single
6 family, multi-family, senior, and affordable homes; and
7

8 WHEREAS, the development master plan includes plans for a
9 new elementary school, but there are no plans for middle or high
10 schools; and
11

12 WHEREAS, there is no designated middle or high school for
13 students who will eventually be living at Koa Ridge; and
14

15 WHEREAS, Mililani Middle School is currently transitioning
16 to a single-track calendar because of overpopulation of students
17 at the school, a project that the Legislature has already
18 dedicated \$23,000,000 to complete; and

20 WHEREAS, this project would be jeopardized if redistricting
21 of Koa Ridge would send additional students to the Leilehua-
22 Mililani-Waialua complex area because Mililani Middle School
23 does not have the resources for additional capacity; now,
24 therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018,
28 that the Board of Education is requested to redistrict students
29 who will be living in the Koa Ridge development to the Pearl
30 City-Waipahu complex area; and
