Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 1169 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to promote careers in
education to Hawaii high school students by funding a program at
the University of Hawaii that promotes the benefits of a degree in
education and the University of Hawaii System campuses that offer
degrees in education.

The University of Hawaii, Department of Education, Hawaii
State Teachers Association, IMUAlliance, and several concerned
individuals supported this bill.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Amending the effective date to July 1, 2050, to
facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 1169, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
