Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1507, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CROSSWALKS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish within the Department of Transportation a two-year Community Crosswalks Pilot Program (Pilot Program), which shall design and implement, in collaboration with the appropriate county departments and agencies, a specially painted crosswalk that represents a neighborhood's unique culture and promotes pedestrian safety;
- (2) Establish a Community Crosswalks Special Fund for the Pilot Program;
- (3) Allow moneys in the Safe Routes to School Program Special Fund to be used for the Pilot Program; and
- (4) Make appropriations for the Pilot Program.


The Department of Transportation opposed this measure. The Department of Budget and Finance provided comments.
