Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred S.B. No. 2174, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MATERIAL WITNESS ORDERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize circuit and family courts to issue material witness orders in cases initiated through felony complaint.

The City and County of Honolulu Department of the Prosecuting Attorney and one individual testified in support of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2174, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass
